- The building name was changed to Chase Tower in late 2005, after Bank One was purchased by JP Morgan Chase & Company.
- The name was changed to Salesforce Tower in 2016 as part of a lease agreement that included naming rights.
- Former site of the Hume-Mansur Building, demolished in 1980, and two lowrise buildings, the Board of Trade Building and Bankers Trust Building.
